The residents to be offered heart transplant cases if they are on call first, but the majority of transplants to be done by the fellows.

The fellows to cover the third room and the second room if a person is on vacation.

If, a chief is on vacation / away one transplant fellow to cover that service.

The chiefs on each service to decide the cases they would like to do and assign the transplant fellows to a room without a chief
